

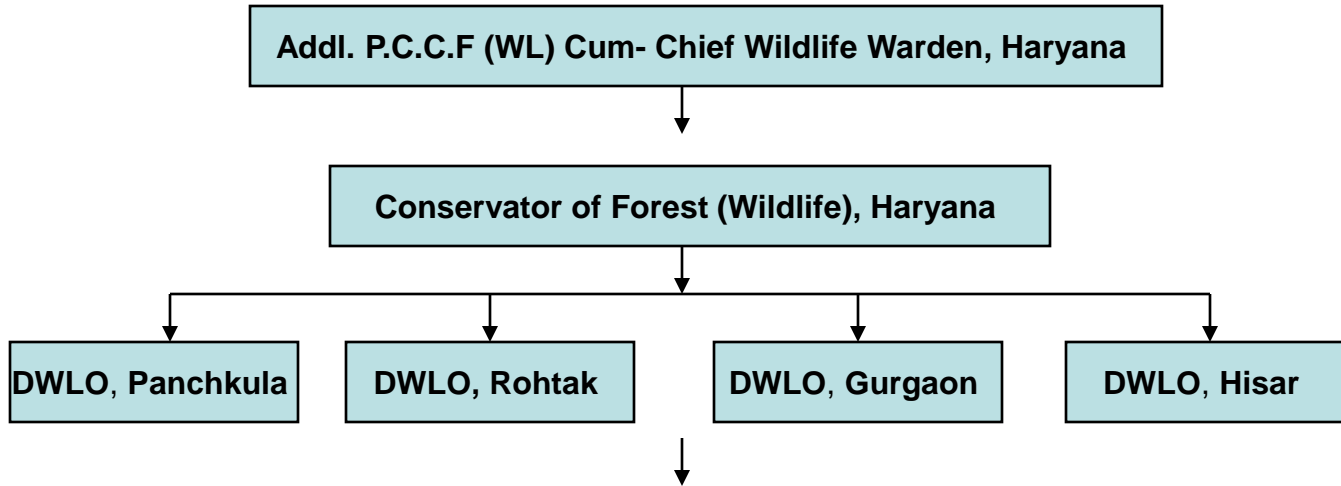
Activities of Wildlife Wing 2009-10



Introduction

Wildlife management in Haryana has special significance because of large variety of avifauna and very little forests only in 3.5% area of the State. The State has about 20 percent of the forest area under protected area network that consists of 2 national parks, 8 wildlife sanctuaries and 2 conservation reserves.

Eco-Sensitive Zones

Government of India issued draft notifications on 29-01-2009 & 03-06-2009 for eco-sensitive zones around 2 national parks and 8 wildlife sanctuaries up to 5 km. distance from the boundary of protected area. Notifications prohibits certain activities like construction, mining and crushing & Polluting Industries maximum up to 5 Km. from the boundaries of these Protected Areas.

DFO, (Territorial) Cum- District Wildlife Warden of the concerned districts have been designated to prepare Master Plans of the Eco-Sensitive Zones declared by Government of India.

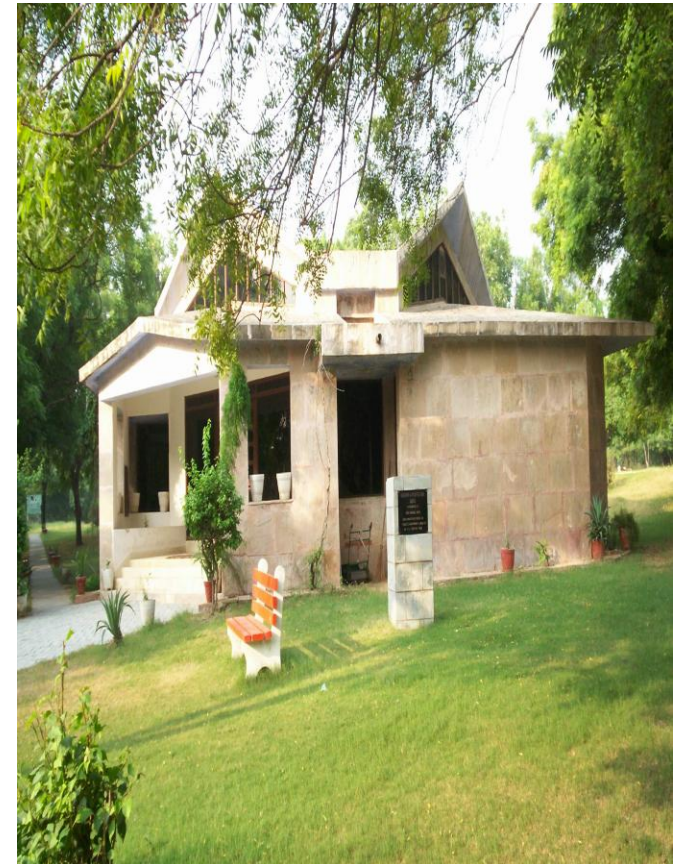

Vulture Project

At present there are 122 vultures at the centre. (52 white backed, 14 slender billed , 54 long billed, 2 Himalayan griffons*)

Twelve eggs laid in the breeding season during 2008-2009.

Four chicks hatched, one died fifty days later.

Cause uncertain. Probably inadequate care / feeding by the parents.

Nesting has started during the current season.

Zoos

There are three zoos in Haryana located at Rohtak (small zoo), Bhiwani (mini zoo) and Pipli (mini zoo), as per the classification of CZA. Recently enclosures for Tiger, Leopard, Desert Fox & Ghariyal has been completed in Bhiwani Zoo and one enclosure for crocodile has been constructed in Rohtak Zoo.

Tigers & Leopards will be introduced in Bhiwani Zoo very soon. The team has already left for Bangalore to bring four tigers.
